O.C.G.A. § 31-7-22(b)(2)(E) Response Regarding Joint Ventures, Partnerships, Subsidiary Holding Companies, and Captive Insurance Companies

The Tift County Hospital Authority (Authority) is a public body corporate and politic organized under the Hospital Authorities Law of the State of Georgia. The Authority was established by the Board of County Commissioners of Tift County, Georgia (County) to operate, control, and manage all matters concerning the County's health care functions. The Authority is governed by a nine-member board of trustees appointed by the County and the County has guaranteed debt of the Authority. For these reasons, the Authority is considered to be a component unit of the County.

The Authority owns and operates Tift Regional Medical Center (an acute care hospital), Cook Medical Center (an acute care hospital, Cook Senior Living Center (a nursing home), and several physician practices. The Authority provides short-term medical, surgical, obstetrical, pediatric, geriatric psychiatry, emergency, and physician care and long-term nursing care.

On June 24, 2015, the Authority formed a limited liability company, CareAlliance: An Accountable Care Organization, LLC (ACO), as the sole member. The ACO is a blended component unit of the Authority.
